The course has been completely marked with a White L , a Green L is also used but most of the marks are WHITE. See photos, additionally there are a few green route arrows, see photo below. If you have an opportunity to ride part of the course over the next few days you can check out the route.

Reminder **all turns are marked**. When proceeding straight you may not see a mark at every intersection, if no mark continue straight. Note that at an intersection where you must turn always look for the marks. And the ride may turn North, South or East, but it NEVER turns WEST!

Ride starting times are staggered to allow the majority of riders to finish reasonably close to each other time wise. Remember this is not a race so please take your time, please obey all traffic laws, and always ride safely. **Helmets are required. No headphones.**

Fundraising: **

If you want to bring a small bag with a change of clothes to the start we will transport it to the finish.

1. **Wantagh ride starts at 6:00 AM:** Registration opens at 5:30 am to check-in and register. Ride starts at the east end of LIRR parking lot just off Park Avenue by the Wantagh Fire Department, use 3470 Park Ave, Wantagh, NY 11793 as address. Parking in LIRR parking

area. Mechanical support at the start. You can leave your car all day. The bus will be returning here

2. Medford start at 9:15 AM: Registration opens at 8:30 am to check-in and register. Ride starts at Tom and Sons Auto Service Center, 2508 New York 112, Medford, NY 11763 located on the corner of Route 112 and Long Island Avenue. Park your car in LIRR Medford train station parking lot located on the east side of Route 112 one block south of Long Island Avenue. Again the bus will be returning to the LIRR parking lot. Mechanical support at this start.

3. Westhampton start at 10:15 AM: Registration opens at 9:30 am to check-in and register. Start location is Fluid Imagery Computing of Westhampton Beach www.fluidimagery.com we are using their parking area, 1 New York 27A (Montauk Highway), Westhampton, NY 11977 southwest corner of the intersection of Montauk Highway and Oneck Lane. Note: it looks like a house. **Very important park your car at the Westhampton LIRR train station located 1/2 mile north from the start.** Oneck Lane when it crosses Montauk Highway becomes Depot Lane, then bike to the start. The bus will be returning to LIRR location. There is no car parking at the actual start. Mechanical support at this start.

Finish - The finish is at school building at 44 Meadow Way in East Hampton located on the grounds of the Most Holy Trinity RC Church and School. The School has no visible numeral address but it is located on Meadow Way directly across the street from 45 Meadow Way in East Hampton, NY 11937.

At the finish riders can relax have lunch and wait for the **bus departing at 4:30 pm.**

2016 LIBC Bike Jersey

EVERYONE will receive a 2016 LIBC jersey, either at the start on Sunday, or a few weeks after the event. If you registered early you will receive it at the start. Please email me and I can let you know if I have your jersey at the start.

BATHROOMS:

Along the route there are numerous opportunities for public bathrooms. Listed are a few:

- Wantagh Start - Lighthouse Diner on south side of Sunrise Highway in Wantagh
- Hilton Hotel where the ride crosses route 110 about 8-9 miles from start
- Brentwood water stop - is at Brentwood State Park which has public restrooms
- Lakeland County Park - in Islandia about 5 miles east of Brentwood water stop
- Medford start and water stop - Fairfield Marriott and Starbucks are located on Route 112

about 1/4 mile north of the waterstop on east side of route 112

- Westhampton - After waterstop the ride travels to beach area on Dune Road (make left on Dune road after going over the bridge) passing public beaches that have restrooms, bikes can ride into the parking lot freely at these beaches and use facilities
- Southampton - Shortly after the waterstop, the ride passes right by Cooper Beach which is the main public beach in Southampton, bike into parking lot to use rest room
- East Hampton - At the finish there will be a portable
